

Black People & Friends

The United States Census Bureau has discriminated against Black People and other minorities in its hiring of census takers. Out of 280 employees for the 1970 census, only one is Black.

The Bureau office at 504 Denslowe Drive has been picketed by our Brothers since April 1. The only result so far has been a physical assault upon the person of a local Black Woman, and a statement by Rodney Reynolds, census director, that he "has nothing against the colored."

Senator Howard S. Cannon, in a telegram, has pledged his support in our fight against this blatant discrimination and tokenism.
