RENO--A three-hour workshop for emergency responders on child and adult sexual assault will be held Thursday, March 1, 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. in Room 104 at Washoe Medical Center.

The workshop, organized by Nevada Area Health Education Centers, in cooperation with the local chapter of the Emergency Nurses Association, will focus on assessing and screening adults and child victims of sexual assault, including physical and behavioral indicators. In addition, community resources and the myths and realities of rape will also be covered. Registration is at the door and anyone interested is invited.

Instructors include Kathleen Peele, R.N., CPNP, clinic director for the Washoe County Sexual Investigation Team, and Diana Sanchez, coordinator for the Rape Victims Assistance Program.
