AIDS issues class in Ely

ELY--A four-hour course for health professionals exploring the ethical dilemmas and feelings surrounding AIDS as well as an update on the latest infection control methods will be held Wednesday, March 21, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. or 6 to 10 p.m. at William Bee Ririe Hospital.

The class, sponsored by Northeastern Nevada Area Health Education Center, will provide four contact hours for physicians, nurses, dentists, pharmacists, medical technicians, respiratory therapists, alcohol and drug abuse counselors, EMTs and social workers.
