Neurological weakness focus of neurology conference

ELKO--The final topic in a series of five one-hour neurology conferences for physicians will focus on neurological weakness Thursday, June 21, noon, at the Commercial Hotel.

Dr. Richard Zweig, M.D., assistant professor internal medicine, University of Nevada School of Medicine, will discuss different diagnostic procedures when a patient is suffering from weakness and evaluation using case studies. Dr. Zwieg is one of three neurologists who has been coming to Elko since February to see patients at the Elko Regional Medical Center and speak at the monthly conferences. A resident in internal medicine will accompany Dr. Zweig.

The program is sponsored by Nevada Area Health Education Centers, which works in partnership with the School of Medicine to provide education for rural health professionals.

Physicians attending will receive one credit hour of category one continuing medical education.
