John Altrocchi, Ph.D., psychiatry and behavioral sciences, gave a presentation with Paul McReynolds and Carolanne House at a poster session of the 7th International Conference on Multiple Personality/Dissociative States in Chicago. The presentation was "Self-Pluralism as a Proposed Contributing Cause of Multiple Personality Disorder."

John Chappel, Ph.D., psychiatry and behavioral sciences, received a grant of \$134,915 for "Faculty Development in Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse" from the National Institute of AAA (ask john).

Joseph Hume, Ph.D., physiology, received a grant of \$119,322 from the National Heart Lung and Blood Institute to study the "Pharmacology/Regulation of Channels and Carriers in the Heart."

Kathy Peele, P.N.P., pediatrics, has received three grants to support the Washoe County Sexual Abuse Investigative Team (SAINT) she heads. She received \$60,000 and \$47,000 from Nevada Welfare, and \$23,000 from Washoe County. The SAINT program provides medical examination and evaluation of children who are suspected of being sexually abused.
