Lars Weiseth, M.D., Ph.D., a Norwegian stress expert, worked with the survivors in each of these disasters, and will describe his experiences at the **Fourth Annual Jones Lecture, Thursday, November 1, 1990, at 4 p.m. in the Manville Auditorium at the University of Nevada School of Medicine.** The topic of his lecture is "Resolving the Stresses Caused by Disastrous Events." Dr. Weiseth is a consultant in disaster stress to the Norwegian defense forces and is a professor of psychiatry at the University of Oslo School of Medicine.
