Julie A. Swain, M.D., has been recruited by the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Department of Surgery to be its new cardiac surgeon. Dr. Swain earned her medical degree in 1973 from Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, and also completed a residency there in general surgery.

Dr. Swain has been an assistant professor of surgery at the University of California, San Diego, and was director of cardiothoracic surgery and medical director of the surgical intensive care unit at Louisiana State University Medical Center in Shreveport, LA.

Before accepting the position in Nevada, she was senior staff surgeon and senior investigator of the Cardiac Surgery Branch of the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, MD.

Dr. Swain's research interests include the study of normal heart and brain function and metabolism to investigate the effects of heart and lung bypass and hypothermia.
