

Med school's Continuing Education program receives accreditation

The University of Nevada School of Medicine's Continuing Education Division was surveyed by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education and has been awarded accreditation for two years, as a sponsor of continuing medical education for physicians. Two years is the maximum period of time allowed for an initial applicant.

"This accreditation is important, because it permits the School of Medicine to extend its educational activities to physicians in practice in the state. It is an additional resource to assure that physicians are receiving medical education throughout their professional lives, keeping them abreast of the latest medical advances in their fields," says Associate Dean Peter Coggan, M.D.

The division will be re-surveyed on 1994.
