Dr. John L. Clowe, president of the American Medical Association, will meet with the media on Sept. 23 to discuss the association's new comprehensive plan to reform the nation's health care system. Access to health care is one of the major problems facing the nation.

The AMA plan has four goals: 1) extend health care coverage to all Americans; 2) control rapidly rising health care expenditures; 3) foster a continued level of excellence in the quality of health care services; and 4) ensure individuals the freedom to choose the type of insurance coverage and health care they receive.

Dr. Clowe is in Reno as the guest of the Washoe County Medical Society and the University of Nevada School of Medicine.
