LAS VEGAS -- Rachel A. Miles, M.D., has been named to pioneer the newly established Division of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, at the University of Nevada School of Medicine. Dr. Miles will be establishing an in vitro fertilization program at the medical school in conjunction with University Medical Center of Southern Nevada.

A Louisiana native, Dr. Miles graduated magna cum laude from Southern University in Baton Rouge with a B.S. in Chemistry. She received her medical degree from Louisiana State University Medical School in Shreveport and completed her residency in obstetrics and gynecology at Tulane University School of Medicine in New Orleans. Dr. Miles also completed a clinical research fellowship in reproductive endocrinology and infertility at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles.

Dr. Miles is a junior member of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and an associate member of the American Fertility Society. She also holds memberships in the American Medical Association (AMA), the Society of Reproductive Endocrinologists and the Southern Medical Association.
