Trudy Larson, M.D., a member of the part-time faculty of the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Nevada School of Medicine, has accepted the full-time position of assistant professor and Vice Chair of the department.

Dr. Larson is an expert in pediatric infectious disease with an emphasis on HIV infection. She will take over administrative duties for the department on its Reno campus. She also will continue to provide support to the Washoe County District Health Department in general pediatrics and communicable diseases, as well as expand her role in developing HIV programs, particularly for pediatrics. One of her tasks will be to help develop an integrated pediatrics program within the Department of Family and Community Medicine.

Dr. Larson is now located on the Reno campus in the newly completed Redfield building, which houses the school's Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology and the University of Nevada, Reno's Student Health Services.
