7) ELDERLY ADDICTS

DRUG ADDICTION IS GENERALLY THOUGHT OF AS A PROBLEM AMONG YOUNGER PEOPLE. BUT ELDERLY PERSONS ARE PRONE TO DRUG ADDICTION AS WELL, SAYS DR. ARNOLD GREENHOUSE, OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA SCHOOL OF MEDICINE:

.17 "You don't see them. A 70-year-old junkie is not too romantic, but there are a fair number of people like this. I suspect one drug that's high on the list is alcohol, which is a more common problem than we think it is."
