Dr. Arvindkumar R. Shah has been named chief of cardiology and professor of internal medicine in the University of Nevada School of Medicine. He also will serve as chief of cardiology at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Reno.

Dr. Shah's research focuses on the clinical aspects of drug therapy in heart disease and the disturbance of arhythm caused by heart disease.

The doctor completed cardiology fellowships at Cincinnati University Hospitals, in Cincinnati, OH; and, in Cleveland, at the Veterans Administration (VA) Hospital, Case Western Reserve University (CWRV) Hospitals and Mount Sinai Hospital. Prior to accepting his new position, he was associate professor at CWRV and director of the Non-invasive Cardiac Laboratory at the VA in Cleveland.
