

Dr. McFarlane Presents Paper at Vanderbilt

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A small, invitation-only conference last month on voice disorders at Vanderbilt University Medical school in Nashville found Nevada's own Stephen McFarlane, Ph.D., presenting research findings. The conference brought together 20 recognized experts from the United States, Canada and Japan.

Dr. McFarlane is professor and chairman of speech pathology and audiology at the University of Nevada School of Medicine, and recently was co-author of "The Voice and Voice Therapy" with Dr. Daniel R. Boone.

Dr. McFarlane presented on "The Science of Voice Evaluation and Treatment" at Vanderbilt's Department of Otolaryngology (ear, nose and throat).
