

Med tech program receives accreditation

A joint educational venture, the first of its kind in the United States, between the University of Nevada School of Medicine and Clark County Community College (CCC), has received an initial five-year accreditation.

The accreditation has been awarded to the Medical Laboratory Technician-Associate Degree Program of CCCC in North Las Vegas by the Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation. The program offers students in the medical technology field the opportunity to either graduate in two years with an associate degree or transfer to the University of Nevada-Reno to pursue a four-year bachelor's degree.
