Dr. Kenneth Maehara, associate professor and director of clinical lab science at the University of Nevada School of Medicine, has been selected for membership in Alpha Mu Tau.

This national honorary fraternity for medical technology has a limit of 250 active members at any time, so to be elected is a distinct honor. It was founded in 1948 with 110 charter members. With the new members for 1989, a total of 550 have been admitted to the fraternity.

The purpose of the fraternity is to provide scholarships for both undergraduate and graduate studies in the laboratory field. Funds are generated through donations, bequeaths or fund raising projects.

Dr. Maehara will receive his membership certificate at the annual meeting banquet which was held this week in Washington, D.C.
