Medical students work with local doctors

BOULDER CITY--Two local physicians will be working with senior medical students from the University of Nevada School of Medicine this month.

Senior medical student Ken Truelson begins a four-week stay with Dr. Joseph Hardy, a local family practice physician, Jan. 17. Mark Waltzman also begins his rotation with Dr. Herve Bezard.

Truelson and Waltzman, along with all fourth-year students, are required to complete a month-long stay with a family practice physician in rural Nevada. They will work side-by-side with Drs. Hardy and Bezard through Feb. 11 to learn more about the practice of rural medicine.

The students' rural rotation is coordinated by the School of Medicine's Nevada Area Health Education Center program.
