A University of Nevada School of Medicine professor has been invited to serve as a member of the Immunology, Virology and Pathology Study Section, Division of Research Grants for the Department of Health and Human Services.

Dorothy Hudig, Ph.D., professor of microbiology, will serve on the study section through June 30, 1997. According to Jerome G. Greene, M.D., director of the Division of Research Grants, "Members are selected on the basis of their demonstrated competence and achievement in their scientific discipline as evidenced by the quality of research accomplishments, publications in scientific journals, and other significant scientific activities, achievements and honors."

Dr. Hudig earned her doctorate in biology and immunology from the University of California, San Diego; and joined the faculty of the School of Medicine in 1984.
