Med school's Academic Hooding Ceremony is Friday

Fifty new Nevada physicians will be honored at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Academic Hooding Ceremony at 6:30 p.m., May 14 at the Reno Hilton's Goldwyn Ballroom.

During this ceremony, senior medical students receive their academic hoods and take the Hippocratic Oath, symbol of their acceptance into the profession of medicine. The Class of 1993 is the fourteenth graduating class to receive their medical degrees from Nevada's only medical school.

This year's hooding speaker is Dr. Alfred Soffer, a distinguished educator and, for 25 years, executive director of the American College of Chest Physicians and editor of *Chest*, the official journal of the organization. Dr. Soffer is a professor of medicine (cardiology) at the Chicago Medical School - University of Health Sciences, and is a member of the editorial board of *Respiration*.

During the ceremony, Dean Robert M. Daugherty presents the Dean's Award to individuals who have made important contributions to the School of Medicine.

This year's award will be presented to Clarence and Martha Jones of Reno "For their -MORE-

unwavering support of higher education; for their belief in the possibilities of science and medicine; and for their financial support that makes miracles come true."

The "Praeceptor Carissimus" Award will be given to Quincy E. Fortier, M.D., of Las Vegas. The award is given annually to a physician whose personal and professional example serves as a role model for new physicians.
