Medical students work with local doctors

BOULDER CITY--Two local physicians begin working with senior medical students from the University of Nevada School of Medicine this month.

Senior medical student Shauna Christiansen begins a four-week stay with Dr. Joseph Hardy, a local family practice physician, April 8. Michelle Zebrack also begins her rotation with Dr. Warren Smith.

Christiansen and Zebrack, along with all fourth-year students, are required to complete a month-long stay with a family practice physician in rural Nevada. They will work side-by-side with Drs. Smith and Hardy to learn more about the practice of rural medicine through May 3.

The students' rural rotation is coordinated by the School of Medicine's Nevada Area Health Education Center program.
