Dr. Stanley Shane will be Hooding Speaker

In a few days, the University of Nevada School of Medicine will induct its 16th class of physicians into the field of medicine.

The Hooding Ceremony, which will be held on **Friday, May 17 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Pioneer Theater, is the highlight of graduation week for medical students. During this ceremony, the 55 members of this class will receive their academic hoods and take the Hippocratic Oath, which is their formal acceptance into the medical profession.

The keynote speaker chosen by the medical school and its graduating students is the school's chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine, Stanley Shane, M.D. Dr. is an able physician, researcher and administrator, who has been the Manville Chairman and Professor of the school's Department of Internal Medicine since 1989, when he joined the School of Medicine Faculty.

Dr. Shane earned his medical degree from the University of Kansas School of Medicine in 1958, completed an internship at Los Angeles County General Hospital, and did residency training in internal medicine at the University of Kansas and West

Virginia University (WVU) School of Medicine, where he also was a fellow in endocrinology and metabolism.

He spent two years in the United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine, where he was an internist specializing in endocrinology, and where he pursued research and clinical activities. Before accepting the position with the University of Nevada School, Dr. Shane was professor of medicine at WVU's School of Medicine, also was associate dean at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

During the past six years, Dr. Shane has been director of the school's residency program and clerkship program for internal medicine, as well as acting chief of medical service for the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Reno.

He is a member of the Residency Review Committee for internal medicine, and is chairman of the Board of Directors of University of Nevada Medical Associates, the school's multispecialty group practice.

Dr. Shane has been a reviewer for the *Annals of Internal Medicine* and *Western Journal of Medicine* since 1991, and was a member of the *Western Journal of Medicine's* Advisory Board for Clinical Investigation from 1991 to 1993.

He is a diplomate of the National Board of Medical Examiners, and the American Board of Internal Medicine; and served as governor of the American College of Physicians for Nevada.

During the ceremony, Dean Robert M. Daugherty also will present awards to four people who have made special contributions to the school.
