Three local students have been accepted into the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Minority Scholars Program. Aaron Bill and Philip Martinez will be seniors at Spring Creek High School, and Sara DeLozier will be a senior at Elko High School.

The program runs June 11 - 17 at the medical school's Reno campus and is designed to excite students about career opportunities in medicine and science. Students participate in research projects, attend discussion sessions and anatomy demonstrations, are given hospital tours, and learn how to prepare for college and medical school.

Each student is competitively selected for the program after completing a rigorous application process. The program is funded by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute.
