Dr. Kathryn Eckert has joined the faculty at the University of Nevada School of Medicine as a pediatric endocrinologist and will be working with Dr. Henry Artman. She is seeing patients up to the age of 21 with endocrine problems including diabetes, thyroid, growth, adrenal and puberty disorders.

After earning her medical degree at Nevada's medical school, Dr. Eckert completed her pediatric residency training and a fellowship in pediatric endocrinology at Stanford University Hospital; and has American Board of Pediatrics Certification in Pediatric Endocrinology, American Board of Pediatrics Certification, National Board of Medical Examiners Certification, and is licensed to practice in Nevada.

Dr. Eckert is on the active medical staff at Washoe Medical Center, Saint Mary's Regional Medical Center and Northern Nevada Medical Center, and on May 1, she started seeing endocrine patients twice a month in Dr. Susan Pintar's office in Carson City.
