STD/HIV Prevention Program

The University of Nevada School of Medicine will host a program for primary care providers on prevention counseling for sexually transmitted diseases (STD) and HIV, via compressed video in locations listed below.

Effective STD/HIV Prevention Counseling for the Busy Primary Care Provider will be the topic. Cornelis (Kees) Rietmeijer, M.D, M.P.H., Health Behavioral Training Program, Denver STD/HIV Prevention Training Center will moderate a panel presentation. Topics will include strategies to integrate client centered STD/HIV risk assessment; behavior change theory and relevant research. Physicians, physician assistants, nurses, nurse practitioners, counselors and educators are invited. Continuing education credit is available for two hours of Category 1 CME for physicians; and two credits for nurses. The program is free, but does require advance registration.
