## Medical emergency management course series offered

The University of Nevada School of Medicine AHEC program will be offering a six-part emergency medical managment course in Hawthorne, beginning July 25.

Parts I and II will be held Saturday, July 25, 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. Parts III and IV are scheduled for Saturday, Aug. 8, 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. Parts V and VI will be held Saturday, Aug. 22, 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. Each section will be held at the Mineral County Library.

The courses, geared to nurses, EMTs and paramedics, will be taught by Dennis Cheek, R.N., M.S.N., clinical instructor, University of Nevada, Reno Orvis School of Nursing and Scott Gruewell, paramedic and training coordinator for REMSA, in Reno. Specifically, each part will cover emergency medical management of the following:

- Part I: cardiovascular systems
- Part II: cardiopulmonary and thoracic systems
- Part III: abdominal and genitourinary systems
- Part IV: endocrine and orthopedic emergencies
- Part V: neurological emergencies and pain management
- Part VI: pediatric life support and stabilization and transport of the critically ill
