

Prentiss Cole is June artist at Manville Gallery

Prentiss Cole will present mixed media constructions for the June exhibit at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery. The show's opening reception will be held on Monday, June 3, 1991, from 5 to 7 p.m. in the gallery.

The California artist earned his master's degree in painting from San Jose State University in 1971, and has had numerous solo and group exhibitions, including 1991 exhibits at Fairfield Civic Arts Gallery in Fairfield, CA; Rosicrucian Egyptian Museum Art Gallery in San Jose; Merced College, lecture and exhibition; and Mountain View Studio.

"Beyond a world that appears exquisite and mysterious and at the same time meaningless and absurd. It would seem there is much more, a totally other, co-existent and inclusive, that may be worth looking into," says Cole.

"I find interesting ideas that bridge art, science, religion and psychology, and in the personal implications of such ideas."

The exhibit will be shown through June 28; gallery hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and the public is welcome to come and browse.
