Contemporary artist Sharon Irene Guy is the exhibitor during March at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery. The mixed media exhibit opens on Monday, March 5 with a reception in the gallery from 5 - 7 p.m., and continues through the month.

Guy earned her undergraduate art degree from the University of Nevada, Reno, and took a master's class at Santa Fe Institute of Fine Arts in Santa Fe, NM. She has exhibited extensively in Reno, with solo shows at SXN Gallery and Front Door Gallery, and group exhibits at Sheppard Gallery, Dice Gallery, Hermitage Gallery, and at Home Federal Bank.

There is an autobiographical element in her exhibit, according to the artist. "Out of self preservation for our precarious sanity, we seek to take the simple objects of our existence and deify them."

Guy's awards include the Craig Sheppard Memorial Art Scholarship, a Sierra Arts Foundation Grant, the Santa Fe Institute of Fine Arts Award and the Houghton Scholarship Award.

Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the public is welcome to come and browse.
