University art professor Jim McCormick is the February exhibitor at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery. The exhibit, titled "Sector: an installation and selected lithographs," will open on Monday, February 5 with a reception from 5 - 7 p.m. in the gallery.

According to McCormick, "'Sector' will include a floor level and wall installation employing several hundred 12"x12" print modules, arranged to adjust the viewer's perception of the Manville Gallery space. In addition, eight color and black and white lithographs, recently executed at the Plucked Chicken Press in Evanston, IL, will be featured."

McCormick earned his bachelors and masters degrees in art from the University of Tulsa in Tulsa, OK. As a University of Nevada, Reno art professor, he offers instruction in printmaking, drawing, visual foundations, art history, papermaking, and other disciplines. He has been with the university since 1960, and received the 1989 University of Nevada Distinguished Teacher Award.

McCormick has had numerous selected one-person exhibitions, including ones at Philbrook Arts Center, Tulsa, OK; Davidson College, Davidson, NC; University of Maine, Orono, ME; Rockford College, Rockford, IL; University of Nevada, Las Vegas; University of Nevada, Reno; and Sierra Nevada Museum of Art.

The professor is a member of the Nevada State Council on the Arts; is on the Board of Directors of the Sierra Arts Foundation, the Sierra Nevada Museum of Art and the Nevada Alliance for Art Education.

The exhibit runs through March 2 and the public is welcome to come and browse. Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.
