The selected works of Seattle artist Bill Braun will be featured in October at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery.

Braun, who is a contemporary artist, attended Reno High School and the University of Nevada, Reno and earned a bachelor of fine arts in 1978 from California College of Arts and Crafts. The artist has had selected exhibitions at the Museum Gallery in San Francisco, Concorde Bank in Dallas, J. Rosenthal Gallery in Chicago, and the Memorial Union Art Gallery and the Bruce Velick Gallery, both in San Francisco. He has also published articles in Artweek and American Craft.

Braun's exhibit opens Monday, October 2, with a reception from 5 to 7 p.m. in the Manville Gallery, and continues through November 3.

Gallery hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and the public is welcome to come and browse.
