Indiana artist Nancy Hutchinson is the July exhibitor at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery. The exhibit will include both color and black and white photography, and the artist has drawn upon many images with paint and pencil. The exhibit opens Monday, July 10, with a reception in the Gallery from 5 - 7 p.m., and runs through July 28.

Hutchinson, who is a photographic hand-colorist, says "my work is concerned with the dual nature of the photograph, existing both as a window and as an object."

Hutchinson received her undergraduate degree in English and a master's degree in media sciences from Purdue University. She also studied art and photography at Purdue and the University of Nebraska, and has taught photography in community college and adult education programs. Additionally, she was employed by Purdue as a photographer for 11 years.

In 1987 and 1988, Hutchinson received second- and first-place awards, respectively, at "The Indiana Arts Competition" in Indianapolis, and earned an Associate Fellowship Grant by the Indiana Arts Commission in 1987.

Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the public is welcome to come and browse.
