California artist Judy Sugden is the June exhibitor at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery. An architect by training, Sugden uses items out of the ordinary environment and places them in differing planes of reality for her Inbetween Space Series.

"Some common useful conventions of focus and representation defy time and space," the artist says. "They allow conceptual comparisons and linkages across disparate contextual boundaries." Sugden adds that these boundaries are ephemeral abstractions and that she attempts to convert them into "physical, real-world space."

Sugden received her bachelor of arts degree in architecture from California Polytechnic University in San Luis Obispo and her master of fine arts in painting at Claremont Graduate School. She has exhibited extensively in California.

An opening reception will be held on June 5, from 5 to 7 p.m. in the Manville Gallery. Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the public is invited to come and browse.
