A father and daughter team will be the exhibitors at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery during February.

Fred Reid has been an instructor in the University of Nevada-Reno's art department since 1974. Early in his career, he exhibited widely as a ceramicist and, more recently, as a painter. In this show, Reid joins his six-year old daughter, Sienna, in presenting recent two-generational works. Sienna's marker pen works of equestrian images become the stimulus for her father's oil crayon works. "Sienna's images are honest and direct," says Reid. "They provide a whole new way of looking at life and an opportunity of experiencing what it is like to be six years old again."

The opening reception for the Reid exhibit is Monday, Feb. 6, from 5 - 7 p.m. in the school's Manville Gallery, and will run through March 3. Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the public is welcome to come and browse. The gallery is partially supported by a grant from the Nevada State Council on the Arts.
