The October exhibit at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery will feature the mixed media works of Reno artist Yari Ostovany, who was born in Tehran, Iran. His show will run Oct. 3 - 28, and the opening reception will be held from 5 - 7 p.m., Oct. 3, in the gallery.

"I rely on my subconscious, or what I believe to ultimately be the collective subconscious," says the artist.

Ostovany attended the University of Tehran Extension in Iran in 1978, San Jose State University Extension in California in 1980, and has studied at the University of Nevada-Reno since 1981.

He has exhibited locally at the Sierra Nevada Museum of Art; North-South Gallery and Getchell Library, University of Nevada-Reno; and the Sheppard Gallery. His works appear in the collections of Joseba Zulaika and Paco Pereda of Spain; and Mark Gandolfo, Jacklyn Schoener and Ulrike Winkler of Reno.

The gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the public is welcome to come and browse. The gallery is partially supported by a grant from the Nevada State Council on the Arts.
