Carson City artist Michael Gilbert is the November exhibitor at the University of Nevada School of Medicine's Manville Gallery.

Although Gilbert's show, "Counterpoint," consists of watercolor, acrylic and magna paintings on paper and masonite panels, the artist also has worked with pottery and ceramic sculpture, ink, oil and pencil.

Gilbert studied at California State University at Fullerton under John Jordon, Dion Myers, Robert Partin and Peter Macke. He received a bachelor of art degree, majoring in ceramics and painting. He also operated "Loza de Barro," a pottery shop at Knott's Berry Farm in Buena Park, California, where he produced and demonstrated making of stoneware pottery.

The artist has exhibited at Sylvia Mesches Gallery in Sherman Oaks, CA; Suzanne Browne Gallery in Scottsdale, AZ; San Diego Art Institute, San Diego, CA; Harrah's Wine and Art Show in Reno; and Empire Mine Art Show in Grass Valley, CA.

The opening reception for Gilbert is Monday, November 2, from 5 to 7 p.m. in the Manville Gallery; the exhibit runs through Dec. 4. Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. The gallery is partially supported by a grant from the Nevada State Council on the Arts.
