This is just one of the unusual pieces created by Tom Ward who will be exhibiting his works at the University of Nevada School of Medicine May 5 - 30. The show also will include oils, acrylics, ceramic pieces and constructions.

Ward believes that art "should be a joyful response to life and that view should be conveyed through color, form, and humor." Humor is always present in this artist's work which is an extension of his personality.

According to Ward, his current works are revelations that occurred during the "blue moon" of last July, 1985. He has been influenced recently by the American folk artist Victor Joseph Gatto
