On behalf of the American Coalition for Filipino Veterans, a national advocacy organization, I am proud to endorse the Filipino Veterans Fairness Act.

This legislation introduced by Senator Dean Heller provides a path for Filipino soldiers who fought honorably in the service of the United States Army during World War II but who were denied official recognition and veteran benefits because they were not included in the belated "1948 Missouri List" of the U.S. Army Personnel Records Center.

However in 1946, these Filipino soldiers were honorably discharged by the U.S. Army, provided with official documentation and pay by the Philippine Commonwealth Army of the United States.

The Heller bill would help us update and simplify the U.S. Army policies and procedures to recognize Filipino veterans' military service and the administration of benefits by the Department of Veterans Affairs to meet the requirements of the 2009 Filipino Veterans Equity Compensation Act.

We deeply appreciate Senator Heller's leadership on behalf of Filipino Veterans of World War II and his efforts to encourage Congress to pass this legislation.
