 or (b) of section 107 of title 38, United States Code, for

 is eligible for benefits described in such subsections.

6 (b) COVERED INDIVIDUALS.—For purposes of this7 section, a covered individual is any individual who—

8 (1) claims service described in subsection (a) or
9 (b) of section 107 of title 38, United States Code;

(2) is not included in the Approved Revised Reconstructed Guerilla Roster of 1948, known as the
"Missouri List".
