## 1SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON CERTAIN TRAVEL AND CON-2FERENCES POLICIES OF AGENCIES OF THE3UNITED STATES.

An agency of the Government of the United States
may not establish or implement a policy that discourages
or prohibits the selection of a location for travel, an event,
a meeting, or a conference because the location is perceived to be a resort or vacation destination.
