AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. HELLER (*Russia, Inhofe, Vitter*)

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle C of title XII, insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SEC. 12213. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR**
4 **HEALTH CARE REFORM IMPLEMENTATION**
5 **BY IRS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of division F of the Con-
7 solidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act,
8 2013 (Public Law 113-6) is amended by adding at the
9 end the following new section:

10 “SEC. 1315. Notwithstanding any other provision of
11 this Act, none of the amounts made available in the Pa-

1 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law
2 111-148) or the Health Care and Education Reconcili-
3 ation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-152) shall be appro-
4 priated to the Internal Revenue Service for the purpose
5 of carrying out any provisions of, or amendments made
6 by, such Acts. No amount shall be appropriated to the
7 Internal Revenue Service under this Act for such pur-
8 pose.”.

9 (b) SENSE OF THE SENATE.—It is the sense of the
10 Senate that—

11 (1) none of the amounts made available in the
12 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public
13 Law 111-148) or the Health Care and Education
14 Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-152)
15 should be appropriated to the Internal Revenue
16 Service for the purpose of carrying out any provi-
17 sions of, or amendments made by, such Acts in fis-
18 cal year 2014 or thereafter; and

19 (2) no amounts appropriated to the Internal
20 Revenue Service, from whatever source, for fiscal
21 year 2014 or thereafter should be used to imple-
22 ment, enforce, or carry out the provisions of, or
23 amendments made by, such Acts.
