Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following:

2 **SEC. 515. PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE**

3 **RESERVE COMPONENTS WHO ARE SEPA-**

4 **RATING FROM THE ARMED FORCES.**

5 Section 1145 of title 10, United States Code, is

6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsections (d) and (e) as

8 subsections (e) and (f), respectively; and

1           (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-  
2           lowing new subsection (d):

3           “(d) PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF  
4 RESERVE COMPONENTS.—(1) The Secretary concerned  
5 shall provide a physical examination pursuant to sub-  
6 section (a)(5) to each member of a reserve component  
7 who—

8           “(A) will not otherwise receive such an exam-  
9           ination under such subsection; and

10           “(B) elects to receive such a physical examina-  
11           tion.

12           “(2) The Secretary concerned shall—

13           “(A) provide the physical examination under  
14           paragraph (1) to a member during the 90-day period  
15           before the date on which the member is scheduled to  
16           be separated from the armed forces; and

17           “(B) issue orders to such a member to receive  
18           such physical examination.

19           “(3) A member may not be entitled to health care  
20           benefits pursuant to subsection (a), (b), or (c) solely by  
21           reason of being provided a physical examination under  
22           paragraph (1).

23           “(4) In providing to a member a physical examination  
24           under paragraph (1), the Secretary concerned shall pro-  
25           vide to the member a record of the physical examination.”.
