AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. HELLER to the amendment (No. 1463) proposed by Mr. McCAIN

Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle C of title V, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 524. EVALUATION OF THE IMPACT OF THE ENLIST-**
- 3 **MENT OF CERTAIN ALIENS IN THE ARMED**
- 4 **FORCES ON MILIARY READINESS.**
- 5 (a) EVALUATION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of De-
- 6 fense shall evaluate—
- 7 (1) whether permitting covered aliens to enlist
- 8 in the Armed Forces could expand the pool of poten-
- 9 tial enlistees in the Armed Forces; and

1 (2) how making covered aliens eligible for en-
2 listment in the Armed Forces would impact military
3 readiness.

4 (b) COVERED ALIENS DEFINED.—In this section, the
5 term “covered aliens” means aliens who—

6 (1) were unlawfully present in the United
7 States on December 31, 2011;

8 (2) have been continuously present in the
9 United States since that date;

10 (3) were younger than 16 years of age on the
11 date the aliens initially entered the United States;
12 and

13 (4) disregarding such unlawful status, are oth-
14 erwise eligible for original enlistment in a regular
15 component of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine
16 Corps, or Coast Guard.
