




## Publisher's Preface.


In this enterprise we have met with the hearty support of the business men and citizens and we herewith thankfully acknowledge the generosity of the people.

## Washoe County.

**W**ASHOE COUNTY is the empire county of the "Battle-born" State. Its resources are such that subsistence would be possible without converse with the outside world. Within the vast area of this political division of Nevada are fertile valleys and timbered mountains.

Truckee river, a clear mountain torrent, crosses the county on its way from the eternal snow fields of the Sierras to the lakes in which its waters rest. This stream possesses the volume and the fall which make it peerless as a source of power. Its current turns the wheels of mills and factories and, diverted over the valleys, causes the production of splendid crops of cereals, hay and vegetables.

The northern portion of the county is sparsely settled and is devoted almost exclusively to stock raising.

In the southern half, scattered along the Truckee and its tributaries are rich farming communities and prosperous towns and villages.

Reno, the county seat, has a population of 6,400 people. Washoe is a historic town in the valley by the same name. Formerly it was the site of a number of large quartz mills in which Comstock ores were worked.

Steamboat is a station on the V. & T. At this point are springs that are noted for their curative properties. There is a flourishing pleasure resort and sanitarium at this place.

Glendale, on the Truckee Meadows, is a prosperous agricultural community.

Wadsworth is the second town in importance in the county. It is the site of large shops of the Central Pacific Railroad Company. Wadsworth has a population of 2,500 and is rapidly growing.

Verdi is a flourishing town in the western end of the county. It has a large box factory and a large saw mill will be built there this winter. A broad-gauge railroad is being extended north from Verdi through an inexhaustible timber belt.

Washoe county is rapidly coming to the front as a mining region. For many years a few small gold and silver propositions had been worked intermittently with varying success. Within the past few months, however, there has been great progress made along this line.

Olinghouse gulch, near Wadsworth, is becoming a heavy producer of gold. This camp keeps two mills over-taxed with rich ore. About twenty claims are yielding pay quartz and rich gravel. This camp has been developed by poor men and has more than paid its way from the start. The newly organized Wedekind district contains a hundred promising claims. One of them is producing a carload a month of ore that runs into three figures. Pyramid, Cedar, Peavine and Lone Pine districts contain a host of gold, silver and copper leads that promise to yield vast quantities of bullion by another season.

## Reno.

**R**ENO, the metropolis of Nevada, is delightfully situated among the eastern foothills of the Sierras in a fertile and picturesque valley.

It is rapidly growing in population, beauty and wealth. While far from being the geographical center of the State, Reno is Nevada's focal point in mining, manufactruing, lumbering and stock raising.

The elevation of Reno is about 4,500 feet. The rarefied air is health giving and inspires energy.

Within the past few months Reno has gained a number of Municipal advantages among which are free mail delivery, house numbering and an electric fire alarm system.

The city has an excellent system of sewers. It is well lighted with gas and electricity. The streets are broad smooth and well shaded. The houses are homes and the population is cultured, sociable and properous.

Educational Institutions—Reno is the site of the University of Nevada, a school that ranks with the older colleges of the east. It has of late years had a vigorous growth and is liberally supported by the tax payers of the State. Graduates from its School of Mines hold responsible and lucrative positions in the four quarters of the globe.

The public schools of this city mantain a high standard of excellence. Students are enrolled from many sections of Western Nevada



St. Mary's academy is an excellent school. It receives a liberal patronage from Protestants as well as Catholics.

Manufactures—A large flouring mill, planing mill, macaroni factory, two brick yards, soap factory and N.-C.-O. car shops constitute the principal manufacturing establishments in this City.

Transportation—Reno is on the main line of the Central Pacific Railroad and is the northern terminus of the Virginia & Truckee R. R. which, with its extension, C. & C. R. R. taps a vast agriculture and mining region. The N.-C.-O. R. R. extends northerly from Reno into the grazing districts of Northwestern Nevada, Northern California and Eastern Oregon.

Mining and Ore Reduction—Within an hour or two's drive of Reno are a number of recently located mining claims that promise to become valuable properties. Development work and ore extraction are proceeding briskly.

The Reno Reduction Works is a two-smelter plant located east of the city. It is fully equipped for handling 60 tons of smelting ore and 20 tons of free milling rock per day. Some custom work is done by this plant, but it is chiefly engaged upon ores from the E. M. & R. Co.'s mines.

Several months ago The Reno Milling and Smelting Company was incorporated. Already its plant is in successful operation. It works custom ores on liberal terms. The plant has a capacity for nearly 100 tons daily.
