Inventory

On May 6 and 7 George Fairchild and I inventoried the Fish Creek Herd Area near Eureka. The inventory was conducted in a B-1 Helicopter from El Aero with Jim Hicks as pilot.

Weather conditions were fair to poor, due to thunderstorms, sporatic rain, and low clouds. Very little flying was done on top of Ninemile, and some horses were probably missed there.

15' Quads were used to record horse numbers and locations, and are attached for reference. The following is a breakdown by 15' Quad of the horses counted.
