## Dear Interested Public:

The Carson City Field Office is renewing the Borda Brother's Term Permit for a period of one year. It involves grazing use in the Carson Plains-Gold Hill, Mill Canyon, and Pinenut Allotments. Upon settlement of the Borda Brothers Estate and subsequent transfer of Base Property, a Term Permit will be issued for a period of ten years.

A Final Multiple Use Decision was issued on August 18, 1995 covering the Mill Canyon Allotment. Grazing Decision's were issued on August 1, 1991 and January 28, 1992 for the Pinenut Allotment. There will be no change in the total number of animal unit months of specified livestock grazing, authorized period of use, kind of livestock, or class of livestock. The terms and conditions have been modified to comply with the Standards and Guidelines established by the Sierra Front-Northwestern Great Basin Resource Advisory Council. If you have any information pertaining to this proposed action, please provide it prior to February 27, 1999.
