Dear Interested Public:

The Carson City Field Office is considering two actions related to livestock grazing. The first is the construction of a three-mile fence dividing the Lincoln Flat Allotment into two use areas (refer to enclosed maps). This project relates to the management action from the Singatse Mountain Range Multiple Use Decision (June 2000) allowing the permittee to improve livestock distribution through the use of range improvement projects. The project will be funded by the permittee.

The second action is the transfer of a grazing permit in the Sunrise Allotment. There will be no change in the permitted use, period of use, or terms and conditions as specified in the Pine Nut Multiple Use Decision dated August 1995.





- 3. Map of Proposed Lincoln Flat Division Fence





LOCATION OF SUNRISE ALLOTMENT




Enclosure No. 2 LOCATION OF LINCOLN FLAT ALLOTMENT
