
Dear Sir/Madam:

The proposed gathering will be conducted in the Carson City District in the areas shown on the enclosed map and as described below.

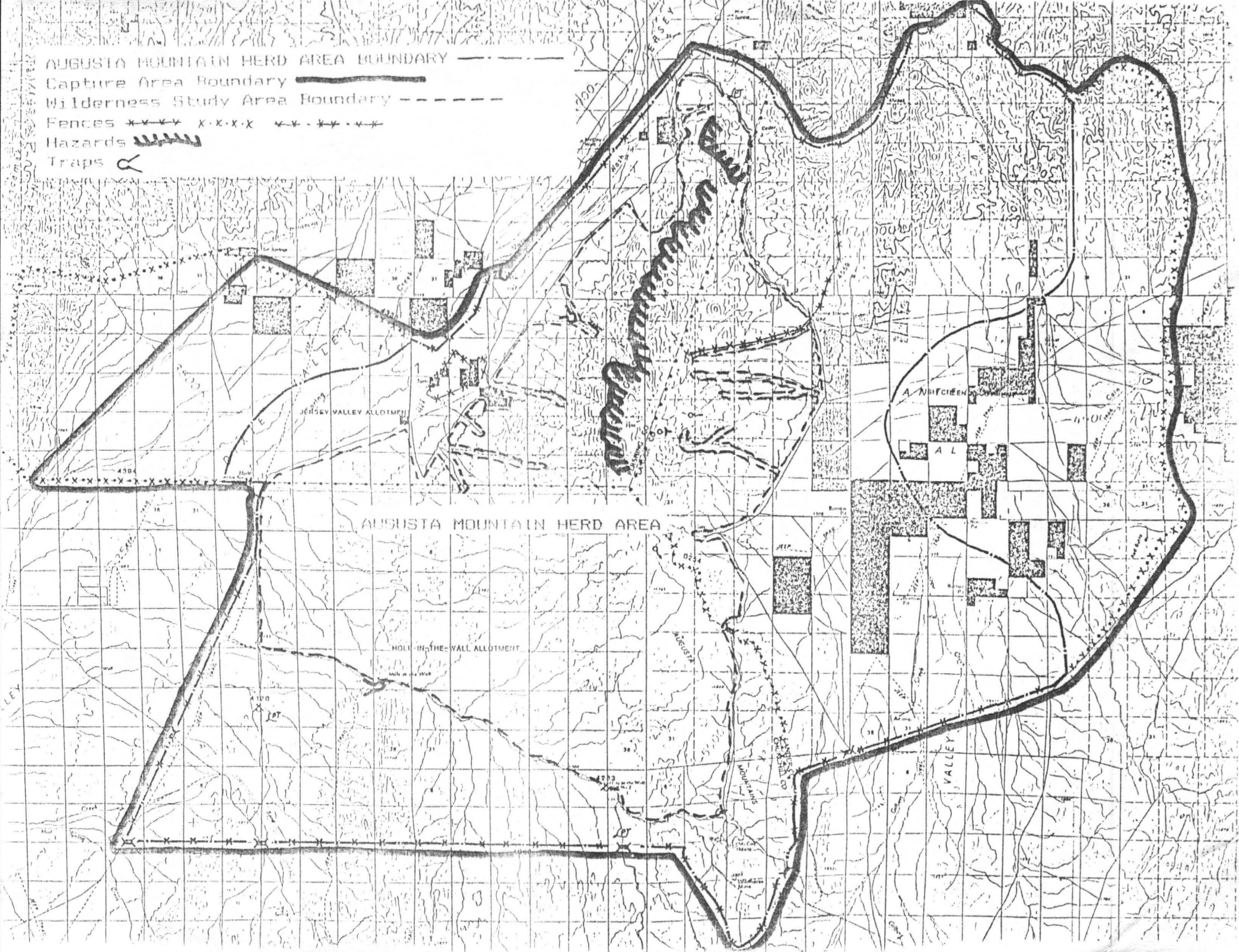

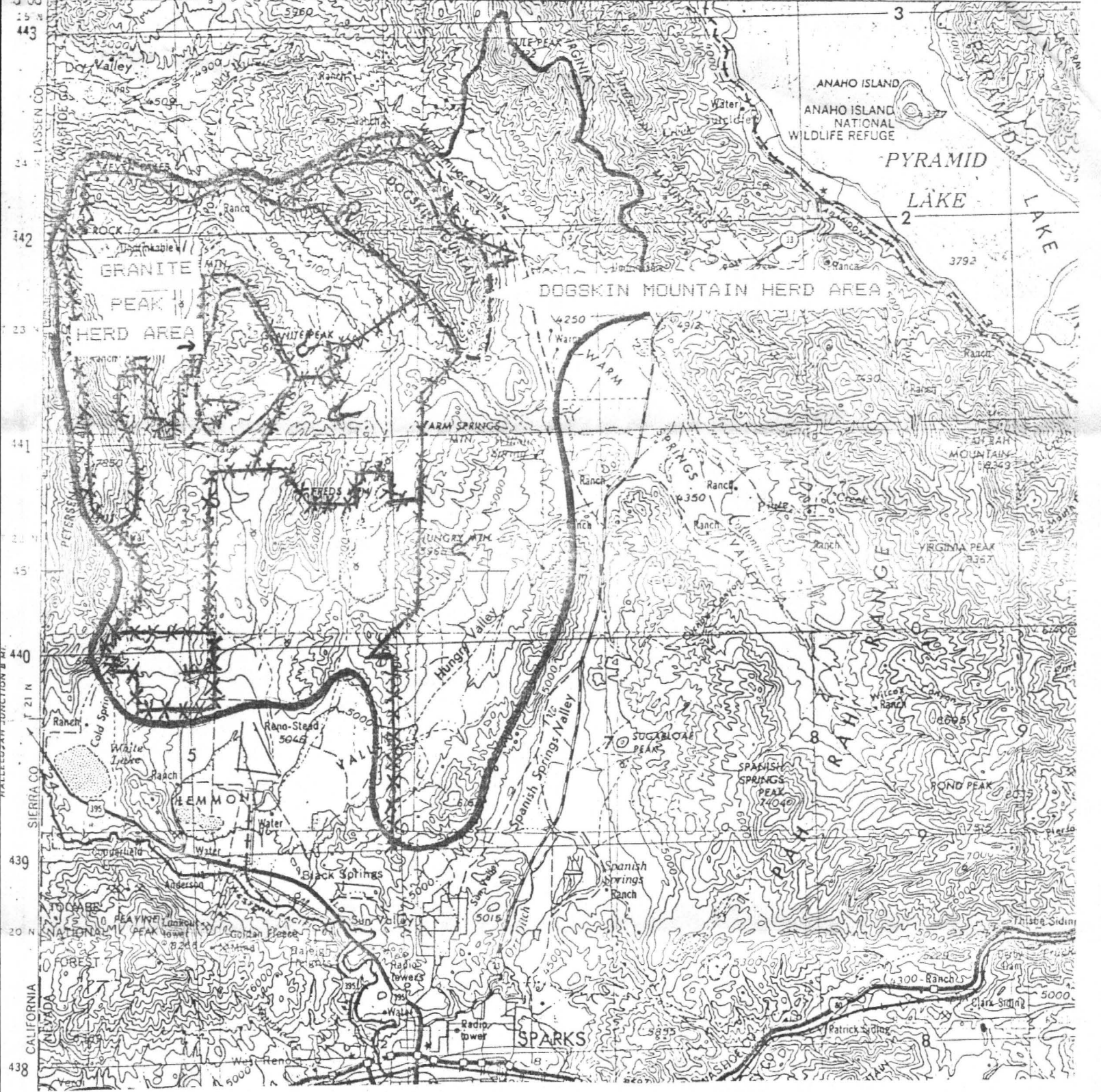
