On 12/16/96, Pete Goicochea applied for a grazing permit for the Railroad Pass Allotment. He meets all of the qualifications for a grazing permittee outlined in 43 CFR 4110.1 and has offered property located in White Pine County which he owns, as base property for the Railroad Pass AUMs. Issuance of this permit complies with the regulations outlined in 43 CFR 4110.2-1 and 4110.2-2. This transfer and permit were approved on 1/23/97.

The terms and conditions outlined in the term permit were developed through CCC with the interested public during the evaluation and decision process and are consistent with the Railroad Pass Allotment Final Multiple Use Decision dated 11/9/95.

The terms and conditions and the impacts of livestock grazing under these terms and conditions are consistent with and have been analyzed in the Egan Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement.

The Diamond Hills South wild horse herd management area is located within this allotment.
