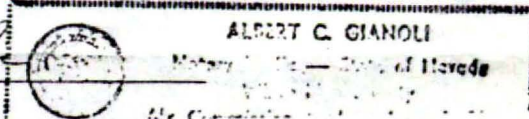

5. These animals are for the most part bunch quitters. That is they leave the main bunch when an attempt is made to gather them. This has had a snow effect as every year these spoiled horses took a few more with them dating back as far as 1967. Due to the extreme ruggedness of the Diamond range these horses are impossible to obtain in these mountains on horseback, otherwise they would not be there. Approximately at this time Julian Goicoechea, *NOT* Cook and Ted Barber were prosecuted for running horses with an airplane, consequently that method of gathering horses was stifled and due to the total reluctance of the former owner to dispose of these renegade horses by any other means they continued in their present state.
