Dear Interested Public:

In accordance with the grazing regulations,"... the authorized officer shall consult, cooperate and coordinate with affected permittees or lessees, the State having lands or responsible for managing resources within the area, and the interested public prior to issuance of non-renewable grazing permits and leases".

On April 22, 1996 Filbert Etcheverry requested temporary non-renewable grazing use on the JD Allotment. His request is as follows:

1. Temporary (one year) conversion of 1,673 cattle AUMs to sheep AUMs.

Approval of the grazing application is consistent with multiple use objectives for this allotment and will not interfere with existing livestock operations on public lands.
