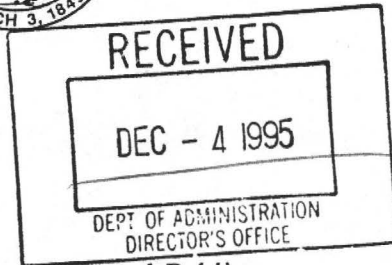

Dear Interested Public:

On August 21, 1995 the new grazing regulations became effective. There are a number of changes included in these regulations. One of those changes is the requirement for consultation, cooperation and coordination with affected permittees or leasees, the state having lands or managing resources within the area, and the interested public prior to the issuance or renewal of grazing permits or leases.

Below is a list of allotments for which I have received applications to transfer permitted use from the current permittee to a new permittee. This requires that I consider issuing new grazing permits to the transferees.

As a result of these transfer requests I may be issuing proposed decisions to each applicant, that either denies the transfer request or approves it and offers a new grazing permit to the applicant.



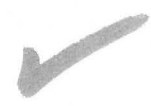
